Login to External Applications with a Password Token

Password tokens are used to login to external applications like Folder Monitor, the Microsoft Office Plugin, GraphPad Prism, and Vernier Logger Pro.

- 1. Sign into LabArchives via the web browser, click your name at the top right and select "LA App Authentication."
- The "Password Token for External Applications" screen will appear. You can use the email address and password token to login to the external application.
