


If your institution has set up Single Sign-On, you can login to LabArchives™ using your institution credentials.

On the LabArchives Login page: mynotebook.labarchives.com, select your institution from the “Sign in through your institution” dropdown list. You will be directed to your institution Single Sign-On page.




Create a New LabArchives Account

If this is the first-time logging into LabArchives, you will be brought to the LabArchives Login Setup Page.

1. On the LabArchives Login Setup page: mynotebook.labarchives.com, enter the email address that you would like to use for your account and click “Create New Account.”
2. When asked “Do you want to create a new LabArchives account?” Click “Yes.”




Link an Existing LabArchives Account

If you previously used LabArchives but this is your first-time logging into the Single Sign-On, you will be brought to the LabArchives Login Setup Page.

- On the LabArchives Login Setup page: mynotebook.labarchives.com, enter the email address and password associated with your account and click "Link Existing Account."
- When asked "Do you want to link this existing LabArchives account?" Click "Yes."






- After this, your LabArchives account will be connected to the Single Sign-On for your institution. Each time you login through the Single Sign-On you will be brought directly to your account.

Login to External Applications with a Password Token

Password tokens are used to login to external applications like Folder Monitor, the Microsoft Office Plugin, GraphPad Prism, and Vernier Logger Pro.

- Sign into LabArchives via the web browser, click your name at the top right and select "LA App Authentication."
- The "Password Token for External Applications" screen will appear. You can use the email address and password token to login to the external application.



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Note: The password is valid for 1 hour. You will need to create a password token each time you login to an external application unless you turn on auto login.
